Other Financial Information

Payment Schedule:

1. Registration fee is due and payable by **July 29, 2011**. A late fee of \$50.00 will be applied after July 31 for all returning students.
2. The first month's tuition and all other fees are due and payable by **August 15, 2011**.
3. The Standard Tuition Payment Plan is ten equal payments. The first payment is due August 15. The remaining payments are due on the 20th of each month of September through May.

Fee:

1. Only after all fees and 1st month's tuition are paid and registration paperwork is completed, can a student be allowed to attend any classes (Locker fee, etc...; Graduation fee for Senior and 8th Grader).
2. All athletic fees (Gymnastics, Soccer, Basketball, Baseball, etc...) payment is required at the time of signup.

Discounts and Financial Assistance

Family Discounts—Families with more than one child attending Edgewood and/or Greater Boston Academy will receive a tuition discount as follows:

- 2 children - 5% discount each
- 3 children - 10% discount each
- 4 or more children - 15% discount each

Prepayment Discount—

- A 2.5% discount will be applied when a full semester is paid in advance (1st semester by August 15, 2011; 2nd semester by January 3, 2012).
- A 5% discount will be applied when the full year's tuition is paid in advance (by August 15, 2011).

Secondary Education Trust Funds (SET funds)—Each academy student whose parent is a member of a Southern New England Conference church is eligible for a subsidy from the SET funds. This subsidy comes in two payments, one in December and one in April. The amount varies, depending on the number of students who apply. **Please note that an application must be completed twice each year in order to receive these funds.**

3-Way Matching Fund— The Southern New England Conference (SNEC) has made provision to grant student aid funds to all qualified Pre K-12 students who might otherwise be deprived of a Christian education who are attending SNEC Elementary Schools and Academies. Once the local church board, using the standard Southern New England Conference application for needy students (completed each semester), determines if the student's family is in need of student aid funds, the church clerk should send the application to the Conference Treasurer, along with a check for the church's share. Once approved by the Conference, a check covering the Conference portion and the church portion will be sent to the school for credit to the student's account. These scholarship funds are paid twice each year, toward the end of each semester (during the months of November and April). Upon receiving these funds, the Business Office will also credit the school's portion of student aid to the student's account. **The application deadlines are October 31 and March 31 for the first and second semesters respectively.** Application forms are available at the Business Office.

Edgewood/GBA Scholarship— The school manages a need-based scholarship program. This fund is available to all qualified Pre K-12 students. To apply for this scholarship, parents must provide financial information to the FACTS tuition management company. A \$20 processing fee is charged by FACTS for their service. **No Scholarships or Student Financial Aid will be awarded outside of this process.** For more information, please contact the Business Office.
